



**MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT ALPHA 2019-2020
MAGAZINES**

Undersigned:

- I. Algemeen Platform Humaniora Amsterdam (ALPHA), Humanities Faculty association of the University of Amsterdam, located on Spuistraat 134, postal code 1012 VB Amsterdam, registered in the Commercial Register of the Netherlands Chamber of Commerce (KVK) under the number 34130680 and hereto legally represented by Mr Tim Vroegindewij, hereinafter referred to as 'ALPHA'.

- II., magazine of study association....., at the University of Amsterdam and hereto legally represented by, hereinafter referred to as 'magazine'.

Declare to have come to the following agreement:

For the period 2019-2020:

1 Rights

Magazines that are a member of ALPHA have a right to the following affairs:

1.1 Subsidies

Magazines that are a member of ALPHA have a right to subsidies for the distribution of magazines, provided that the conditions as regards subsidy applications are met, these can be found on the website of ALPHA. By signing this contract, the magazine agrees with the conditions as regards subsidy applications.

1.2 Voting rights

Magazines that are a member of ALPHA have a right to one vote during a voting at the General Council Meeting (ARV).

1.3 Interest representation

Magazines that are a member of ALPHA have a right to interest representation at ALPHA. This means that ALPHA will promote the interests of the study association when making decisions that concern the study association, to the extent that this can be reasonably expected of her.

2 Obligations

Magazines that are a member of ALHPA have the following obligations:

2.1 Obligation to attend

Of the study associations that are a member of ALPHA at least the chair and the treasurer should be present at the General Council Meeting (ARV for short), the General Assembly of Members (ALV for short), and at the first information session where the budget of ALPHA is presented and further information about the GPP of ALPHA is provided.

2.2 Magazine

Magazines that are a member of ALPHA should send one copy of each edition to ALPHA for inspection.

2.3 Deadlines

Study associations that are a member of ALPHA should maintain the set deadlines.

2.4 Annual financial report

Magazines that are a member of ALPHA should hand in a copy of the annual financial report to ALPHA at the end of the fiscal year.

2.5 Formation editorial board

Magazines that are a member of ALPHA should have an editorial board of which the majority consists of students of the University of Amsterdam.

2.6 Sale

Magazines that are a member of ALPHA should make their paper editions available to students of the Faculty of Humanities free of charge. In case the magazine is of exceptional quality, the magazine already fulfils this requirement when a number of paper editions are placed in the magazine stands at UvA.

If the magazine is only published online, then the magazine should be available to students of the Faculty of Humanities free of charge.

2.7 Acquisition

Magazines that are a member of ALPHA should appoint someone who will be responsible for acquisition. This person should furthermore be present at the Acquisition Information session organised by ALPHA, together with at least one other member of the editorial board.

2.8 House rules 2.01F/G

The house rules of 2.01F/G are to be observed.

3 Sanctions

3.1 Complying with obligations

In case of non-compliance with the obligations of study associations, ALPHA is in a position to deny rights.

3.1.1 Absence

In case the magazine is not present at the mandatory activities, a deliberation with the attending magazines will take place as to whether the subsidy application of the magazine in question will be declared void.

3.1.1.1 Providing ALPHA is notified of the absence by the magazine via email 24 hours before the start of the mandatory activity, accompanied by a valid reason for this, and the magazine has demonstrably tried its best to be present, the absence will not be followed by sanctions.

3.1.2 Deadlines

In case the subsidy application arrives late, but is received within 24 hours after the deadline, accompanied by an explanation for the omission, ALPHA will discuss internally the possibility of nevertheless (partially) granting the application.

3.1.3 House rules

Failure to honour the house rules of 2.01F/G is seen as a serious hindrance by ALPHA. ALPHA is in a position to temporarily, but for no more than 30 days or until the hindrance has been resolved, refuse the magazine payment of the next subsidy.

In case the hindrance is very serious and/or is long-term, then ALPHA is in the position to cancel the next subsidy completely. The next subsidy can also be a subsidy that falls within the next academic year, namely 2020-2021.

3.2 Misconduct

In case misconduct occurs at the study association, ALPHA is in a position to end the membership.
