



**MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT ALPHA 2019-2020
STUDY ASSOCIATIONS**

Undersigned:

- I. Algemeen Platform Humaniora Amsterdam (ALPHA), Humanities Faculty association of the University of Amsterdam, located on Spuistraat 134, postal code 1012 VB Amsterdam, registered in the Commercial Register of the Netherlands Chamber of Commerce (KVK) under the number 34130680 and hereto legally represented by Mr Tim Vroegindewey, hereinafter referred to as 'ALPHA'.

- II., study association at the University of Amsterdam, located on, postal code, registered in the Commercial Register of the Netherlands Chamber of Commerce (KVK) under the number and hereto legally represented by, hereinafter referred to as 'study association'.

Declare to have come to the following agreement:

For the period 2019-2020:

1 Rights

Study associations that are a member of ALPHA have a right to the following affairs:

1.1 Subsidies

Study associations that are a member of ALPHA have a right to subsidies for study-related activities, provided that the conditions as regards subsidy applications are met, these can be found on the website of ALPHA. By signing this contract, the study association agrees with the conditions as regards subsidy applications.

1.2 Voting rights

Study associations that are a member of ALPHA have a right to one vote during a voting at the General Council Meeting (ARV).

1.3 Interest representation

Study associations that are a member of ALPHA have a right to interest representation at ALPHA. This means that ALPHA will promote the interests of the study association when making decisions that concern the study association, to the extent that this can be reasonably expected of her.

2 Obligations

Study associations that are a member of ALHPA have the following obligations:

2.1 Disaster Fund

Study associations that are a member of ALPHA should offer an annual one-off contribution to the Disaster Fund. The Disaster Fund functions as an insurance and is intended to support study associations facing financial difficulties. The remaining amount at the end of each year is divided among the study associations. The amount of the contribution depends on the number of members in the study association:

Number of members	Contribution Disaster Fund
0-30	€0,-
31-70	€20,-
71-120	€40,-
121-300	€70,-
>301	€160,-

This contribution must be paid before 1 November 2019 by transfer to the bank account number NL59 INGB 0008 7431 20 in the name of Algemeen Platform Humaniora Amsterdam.

Upon receipt of this contribution, the remainder of the contribution from the preceding year will, if applicable, be refunded. An application to the Disaster Fund should be submitted no later than one week before the start of a General Council Meeting.

2.2 Obligation to attend

Of the study associations that are a member of ALPHA at least the chair and the treasurer should be present at the General Council Meeting (ARV for short), the General Assembly of Members (ALV for short), and at the first information session where the budget of ALPHA is presented and further information about the GPP of ALPHA is provided.

2.3 Inclusion mailing list

Study associations that are a member of ALPHA should include ALPHA in the mailing list of the study association.

2.4 Membership privileges

Study associations that are a member of ALPHA should offer the same privileges to the board members of ALPHA as to their own members.

2.5 Deadlines

Study associations that are a member of ALPHA should maintain the set deadlines.

2.6 Annual financial report

Study associations that are a member of ALPHA should hand in a copy of the annual financial report to ALPHA at the end of the fiscal year.

2.7 House rules 2.01F/G

The house rules of 2.01F/G should be observed.

3 Sanctions

3.1 Complying with obligations

In case of non-compliance with the obligations of study associations, ALPHA is in a position to deny rights.

3.1.1 Absence

In case the study association is not present at the mandatory activities, a deliberation with the attending study associations will take place as to whether the subsidy application of the study association in question will be declared void.

3.1.1.1 In case the chair or treasurer of the study association is unable to attend one of the mandatory activities for good reasons, he or she should send at least one other board member to the mandatory activity.

3.1.1.2 Providing ALPHA is notified of the absence by the study association via email 24 hours before the start of the mandatory activity, accompanied by a valid reason for this, and the study association has demonstrably tried her best to be present, the absence will not be followed by sanctions.

3.1.2 Deadlines

In case the subsidy application arrives late, but is received within 24 hours after the deadline accompanied by an explanation for the omission, ALPHA will discuss internally the possibility to nevertheless (partially) grant the application.

3.1.3 House rules

Failure to honour the house rules of 2.01F/G is seen as a serious hindrance by ALPHA. ALPHA is in a position to temporarily, but for no more than 30 days or until the hindrance has been resolved, refuse payment of the next subsidy.

In case the hindrance is very serious and/or is long-term, then ALPHA is in the position to cancel the next subsidy completely. The next subsidy can also be a subsidy that falls in the next academic year, namely 2020-2021.

3.2 Misconduct

In case misconduct occurs at the study association, ALPHA is in a position to end the membership.
